Bylaw for the Control of Post Construction Stormwater Runoff Chapter W- Water Resources Advisory Committee (W.R.A.C.)

Mr. Steve Probst and Mrs. Helen Probst were present before the Board to discuss the adoption of Stormwater By Law Chapter W to address post construction stormwater runoff. The goal of the bylaw is to protect local water resources. Stormwater runoff is one of the largest pollutant sources to surface bodies and as well as to the groundwater reservoirs. This Bylaw takes steps towards Acton Meeting the mandated reductions in nonpoint source pollutants and establishes minimum stormwater requirements that will protect our watersheds.

Ms. Probst is asking that the Board of Health adopt this Bylaw so that it can be brought before town Meeting for approval. The Board stated that they would like more time to discuss this request and continued this subject until the next meeting

42 Esterbrook Road-Lift Restrictions


In December 2000, a deed restriction was placed on the property located at 42 Esterbrook Road for three bedrooms. The leaching field has been determined to be an adequate size for a 4 bedrooms home as long as the septic tank was replaced. On May 11, 2012, Lon Nichols pulled a permit to increase the property to a four bedroom home and installed the new septic tank. The Owner, Mrs. Ann Erickson Shaw and Mr. Keith W. Shaw requested that the board lift the deed restriction.

On a motion made by Mr. McInnis, second by Dr. Taylor, the Board unanimously voted to lift the deed restrictions at 42 Esterbrook Road.

The meeting was called to order at 7:35 p.m.

Tobacco Regulations-Continued

The Board of Health Meeting continued the public hearing and discussed the proposed amendments to the Tobacco Regulation that were continued from the previous meeting. The Board reviewed the draft amendment and discussed the three key changes that are banning the sale of tobacco in pharmacies, banning the sale of single cigars under the price of \$2.50 and banning the sale of blunt wraps. The Board closed the public hearing.

On a motion made by Mr. Conoby and seconded by Mr. McInnis, the Board unanimously voted to close public hearing of Tobacco Regulations. On a motion made by Mr. Conoby and seconded by Mr. McInnis, the Board unanimously voted to adopt the proposed Tobacco Regulations.

Regarding Septic System Being Installed at 2 Myrtle

Mr. and Mrs. Kelly owners of 25 Pope Road and abutters to 2 Myrtle Road have made a complaint regarding the septic system that was recently installed at 2 Myrtle Road. Mr. Kelly stated that a portion of their fence was found to be located on the abutter's property and has now been removed. Mr. Kelly is also concerned with the elevation of the new septic system as it now slopes towards their back yard and the toe of the slope is approximately 1-2 feet from their property line and is very concerned with the drainage onto his property. Title 5 requires the slope to be no closer than 5 feet or a swale has to be installed. Additionally Mr. Kelly is also concerned with the very tall vent pipe. The original plan had the tall vent pipe located next to the screen porch. Mr. Kelly stated that the location of this pipe is an eyesore and reduced their property value and asks that it be placed as per the approved design.

At this point, The Health Department has not signed off Certification of Compliance The Board directed the Health Department to contact the engineer and ask why the vent pipe was relocated, if the toe of the slope is closer than 5 feet to the abutters property line and when we should expect the as-built. On a motion made by Mr. McInnis and seconded by Dr. Taylor, the Board unanimously voted to continue the discussion of 2 Myrtle Drive, until the next meeting.


The Board requested to have Central Mass. Mosquito Control Project to come to the meeting in July for an update.
