**Emergency Beaver Trapping-204 Pope Road and 13 Birch Ridge Road**

An emergency beaver trapping and dam breaching has been requested due to the impact on human public health and property safety issues at 204 Pope Road and 13 Birch Ridge Road. The Health Department recommended that the Board approve a ten day period emergency permit, beginning on November 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2011. If more time is needed a thirty day extension can be applied for with the Division of Fisheries Wildlife. On a motion made by Mr. McInnis, seconded by Ms. Bissetta, the Board unanimously voted to approve emergency beaver trapping permits at 204 Pope Road and 13 Birch Ridge Road for a period of ten days.


**22 Tuttle Drive-Amendment of Conditions**


Mr. Halley presented the owner's request for an official review of a previously granted variance dated June 24, 1996 to not allow increase in design flow or square footage at 22 Tuttle Drive. In March, 2008, revisions were made to 310 CMR 15.000, specifically to 15.405(h) in which Title 5 no longer restricts the increase on the square footage of the property. The Board discussed and requested that the owner provide a proposal with details, as well as an As-Built. There is no motion at this time.
