**SUMMONS AND ORDER OF NOTICE**


To the above-named Defendant:

You are also required to file your answer to the complaint in the office of the Clerk of this Court at Woburn either before service upon plaintiff's attorney or within a reasonable time thereafter.

Unless otherwise provided by Rule 13(a), your answer must state as a counterclaim any claim which you may have against the plaintiff which arises out of the transaction or occurrence that is the subject matter of the plaintiff's claim or you will thereafter be barred from making such claim in any other action.
