Notable Changes

Fluorescent light bulbs, televisions, CRT's, medications and sharps will no longer be accepted at Hazardous Waste Day. Please see below for means of disposing of these items:

Acton Transfer Station (see website for hours or call 978-929-7742):

- Fluorescent light bulbs
- Televisions and CRT's - \$25 charge per unit and is payable at the entrance to the Transfer Station by cash or check payable to the "Town of Acton." This fee will help cover the cost for disposal of these items.
- Uncontaminated waste oil
- All rechargeable batteries/car batteries. Alkaline batteries can be thrown away regular household trash.

Transfer Station or recycling sticker required, recycling sticker is \$15 annually (\$10 for seniors 65+)

Acton Town Hall:

- Sharps (syringes) can be brought to the left foyer of the Town Hall located at 472 Main Street, from 8am-5pm, Monday-Friday excluding holidays and dropped into the red kiosk labeled sharps.

Acton Public Safety Facility:

- Medications can be dropped off in their original container in the front foyer of the Public Safety Building located at 371 Main Street 24-hours per day.
