CONSERVATION COMMISSION MEETING
MARCH 23, 1983

CALL TO ORDER: 7:45 P.M.

COMMISSIONERS PRESENT: Judy Clark, Mary Donovan, Dana Sawyer, Thomas Taylor and Michael Graesser.

ALSO PRESENT: Rae Kilkenny, associate member and Julie Lipton, Conservation Assistant.

ITEM 1: F.Y. 1983 Budget - Expenses (Line Item 30)

On the Motion of Judy Clark, seconded by Michael Graesser it was unanimously voted to amend line item 30 from \$2,105 to \$3,105 at Town Meeting.

The requested \$1,000.00 dollar increase is to be allocated for a boardwalk at Grassy Pond. Michael Graesser was assigned to speak at town meeting in favor of the amendment.

ITEM 2: F.Y. 1983 Budget - Salary (Line Item 29)

On the motion of Thomas Taylor, seconded by Dana Sawyer, it was unanimously voted to amend line item 29 to include an increase of 10 hours. Cynthia Torkelsen was assigned to speak at town meeting in favor of the amendment. Mr. Taylor was assigned to speak to this item in the event that Mrs. Torkelsen could not.

ITEM 3: Election of Chairman

On the motion of Judy Clark, seconded by Michael Graesser, it was unanimously voted to elect Cynthia E. Torkelsen as the official Conservation Commission Chairman.

ITEM 4: Rules and Regulations


Thomas Taylor presented a revised copy of Rules and Regulations for review and discussion.
