7:15 Chairman Terry Maitland opened the meeting and read the Virtual Meeting guidelines. The Chairman announced that the hearing for 7 Horseshoe Drive would be continued to the September 7<sup>th</sup> meeting at 7:30 PM and would be held virtually. Additionally, the hearing for 225 Newtown Road would be continued to the September 7<sup>th</sup> meeting at 7:35 PM and would be held virtually.

**7:17 75 Spruce & Elm Street; DEP 85-1286**

Presenting on behalf of the applicant was Jeremiah Driscoll and Mike Brawley from Consigli Construction. The two were requesting a redline change to allow a temporary walkway leading from the teachers parking lot to the bridge, until the spring when demolition/construction continues. Jeremiah showed the approved plan from the Order of Conditions and explained where the temporary walkway would deviate. The chairman asked if the temporary path would have more or less impact on the wetlands; Jeremiah explained that the path would be further from the wetlands when it deviates from the footprint of the permeant path. Jeremiah said that Mike Gendron and Amy Green were on site and observed the proposed path; Mike and Amy confirmed that it would be further from the wetlands. Jim Colman expressed concern that the stone dust path would erode from rain and asked what erosion prevention would be in place. Jeremiah explained that the pathway would be slightly depressed and the edges of the walkway would be higher than the stone dust layer.
