CURRENT

Overview

The Advisory Committee will hold public hearings and meet with government officials and community interest groups to gather information and ideas from as wide a range of stakeholders as possible about the offer from the Executive Office of Transportation to build a second level parking deck at the South Acton commuter rail station. The Committee will condense the information and compile recommendations reflecting the various points of view, and arguments in support of, or opposing, the parking deck.

By June 30, 2009, the Committee will submit its report to the Selectmen for consideration.

Membership is comprised of one member from the Finance Committee, two residents in proximity to the South Acton train station, one member of the Transportation Advisory Committee, and five Citizens-at-large

PROPOSED

Overview

The South Acton Train Station Advisory Committee will work with MBTA representatives to develop and approve a design for the new commuter rail station, the Town owned parking lot, and adjacent MBTA property, including possible parking or other uses for any property acquired as a part of the project. The Committee shall coordinate its work with Assebet River Rail Trail, Inc., the Town Planner and community groups having an interest in improvements to the commuter rail station and surrounding property. The Committee shall report to the Selectmen periodically on its progress and shall seek appropriate approvals from the Selectmen as needed for any necessary funding for elevator maintenance or other costs to be born by the Town.

Members

Membership is comprised of one representative appointed by the Selectmen, one member appointed by the Finance Committee, two residents in proximity to the South Acton train station appointed by the Selectmen, one member appointed by the Transportation Advisory Committee, and five Citizens-at-large appointed by the Selectmen.
