Opening

Chair Derrick Chin called the meeting to order at 7:37pm. He read the guidelines for virtual meeting.

Mr. Chin called the roll: Derrick Chin - Aye, Ray Yacouby - Aye, and Sam Bajwa - Aye, Unanimous (3-0)

I. New/Special Business

1.1 PB 20-07 - Continued Public Hearing - Planned Conservation Residential Community (PCRC) Special Permit - 22 Elm Street

At 7:47pm, Mr. Chin reopened the continued public hearing.

Mr. Cappetta was not available for tonight's Planning Board meeting, planning staff will work with Mr. Cappetta on completing the Mullin Rule certification prior to the next Planning Board meeting once he can review the zoom recording.

Mr. Donohoe from Dillis & Roy presented an overview of the proposed PCRC project and the updates from the last public hearing on the application.

The Board members had questions for the applicant's engineer regarding what has been resolved in the response letter to the peer review letter, dated December 14, 2020. The Board members were concerned that the health regulations weren't being met by the proposed project. The Board asked the town staff if they have received any feedback to confirm that the health regulations are being met from the Health Division and Mr. Hummel read the Health Division comments into the public record. The Board also asked if the Fire Chief has reviewed the proposed fire engine turning path. Mr. Hummel read the Fire Department comments into the public record.

The Board also discussed the need for a traffic study, a lighting plan, 3D renderings, and sidewalks within the proposed development and along the frontage of Elm Street.

Neighbors had questions about the lack of 3D renderings, the number of units that can fit on the lot to be compatible to the neighborhood, lack of neighborhood outreach, and the waivers that the applicant is seeking. Danny Factor read a letter behalf of Green Acton.

The Board took a straw poll and advised the applicant's engineer to prepare 3D renderings of the proposed dwellings from Elm Street prior to the next continued public hearing. The Board also



recommended for the applicant's engineer to conduct public outreach with the Elm Street neighbor prior to the next public hearing.

After a back and forth discussion with the applicant's representative and hearing from the public and staff, Mr. Yacouby moved to continue the 22 Elm Street PCRC Special Permit until February 16, 2021 at 8:15 PM via Zoom. Mr. Bajwa 2nd the motion. Mr. Chin called roll. Ray Yacouby - Aye, Sam Bajwa - Aye, and Derrick Chin - Aye. The vote was unanimous (3-0).

II. Regular Business

Citizen Concerns

Danny Factor on behalf of Green Acton wanted to ask the board how much time he will have later in the meeting to address Green Acton's concerns regarding the proposed 22 Elm Street PCRC project. The applicant will reach out to Mr. Walter on behalf of the neighborhood.

Previous Meeting Minutes

At 9:34 PM, Mr. Yacouby moved to approve the 12-15-2020 meeting minutes as presented, Mr. Chin 2nd. Mr. Chin called roll: Sam Bajwa - Aye, Ray Yacouby - Aye, and Derrick Chin - Aye. The vote was unanimous (3-0).
