  Preservation Committee (CPC) funds. The Board decided to submit two
  proposals. The first proposal would be for money to supplement the family-selfsufficiency position so that the staff person can work with our state families. The

second proposal would be to establish a trust which the Housing Authority could use for construction projects.

Ms. Baran updated the Board on the activities of the Acton Community Housing Committee (ACHC). The (ACHC) may be applying for CPC funds to assist with affordable housing purchases for families.

Ms. Cronin presented information on the smoke eater products. The supplier could not furnish the names of other businesses in MA who have their products and they could not provide a demonstration. The Board suggested that the tenant who was advocating for these products be contacted to see if he could help get information on other products.
