4. Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) for Families with Children

Food resource benefit provided to families approved for free and reduced school meals. Benefit cards will be issued to families in the upcoming weeks and will include funds to purchase groceries at local stores in the amount of \$5.70 per day that school has been out of session.
