The Acton Fire Department is pleased to announce that we will be resuming residential smoke detector inspections on **Monday, June 15, 2020**. Our fire personnel will take necessary safety precautions during the inspections.

The following guidelines prior to the inspection must be met in order for the inspection to take place.

- The house shall be unoccupied for 30 minutes prior to the inspection
- One person must accompany the inspector. IE Either the realtor, the seller, or a person representing the seller.
- Cash will not be accepted.
- \$50.00 Fee by check can be made payable to the "Town of Acton".
- You will be asked to fold and place the check in a small plastic bag which the fire department will provide.

Note: It's important that these guidelines are met so the inspection can be performed. If not, the inspection will need to be rescheduled.

If a request is made to have the fire department perform on-site guidance for the smoke detector requirements. The house shall be unoccupied for 30 minutes prior, and only one person may accompany the inspector.

Prior to the inspection, it's important to check all smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors to be sure they function. Smoke detectors must be replace if older than 10 years.
